

5.80.060 - License suspension—Revocation.

- A. The director of forestry may request that the city attorney investigate and determine whether to instigate proceedings for a license to be suspended or revoked for the following reasons:
 - 1. Violations of city ordinances, including, but not necessarily limited to, the provisions of this chapter and/or Chapters 5.04 and 12.16 of the city code, or Wyoming law;
 - 2. Activities and operations provided under a license demonstrating lack of knowledge or education resulting in unsafe or improper practices affecting employees, the public and/or the intent of the urban forestry program in protecting and preserving the community's trees and shrubs;
 - 3. Allowing an unlicensed business or individual to operate under licensee's business license.
- B. In the event proceedings are instigated for a license to be suspended or revoked, the provisions of Sections 5.04.100 and 5.04.110 of the city code will apply.
